## American Society of Echocardiography Announces its 2022-2024 Leadership Academy Cohort

(DURHAM, NC, Oct. 18, 2022)—The American Society of Echocardiography (ASE) is pleased to announce the participants who will make up its third ASE Leadership Academy cohort. The 15-members of the 2022-2024 cohort, were selected from a large pool of highly qualified applicants. They will spend the next 20 months training to increase their knowledge and develop skills to help become successful leaders in the field of cardiovascular ultrasound.

The ASE Leadership Academy program is composed of didactics, and experiential, self-directed, and peer-to-peer learning. Participants are matched with a senior adviser, acquire a personalized evaluation of their leadership aptitude, and receive high-quality online tutorials on leadership topics. At the completion of the program, successful candidates are eligible to serve a term on the ASE Board of Directors.

The ASE Leadership Academy Selection Task Force, which was led by Program Director and ASE Past President **Vera Rigolin, MD, FASE**, selected a diverse group made up of nine physicians and six sonographers from 11 states.
