ARE YOU READY TO APPLY FOR FASE?

For Veterinarians, check it out below.

The points guideline below is designed to help applicants determine if they are eligible for FASE. Proof of board certification, subspecialty cardiovascular ultrasound certification (if available), CME, three (3) letters of recommendation, and all other submitted materials are reviewed by the FASE Advisory Committee to determine if applicants meet the FASE criteria. Final eligibility will be determined by the FASE Advisory Committee after careful review of the submitted materials.

Supporting letters must reflect the FASE requirements and will be assessed by verifiable participation in TWO or more of the three professional categories within the past five years.

SUPPORTING LETTERS – Three (3) Letters are Required:

Supporting letters and curriculum vitae will be assessed by verifiable participation in TWO or more of the three professional activities within the past five years. Supporting letters must reflect the FASE requirements and may be submitted from any of the following sources:

- Current FASE member
- ASE Board of Directors, Committee, Taskforce, or Council Board members
- Officer of a local, regional, national, or international cardiovascular ultrasound society
- Faculty of an accredited cardiovascular ultrasound program or physician training program
- Medical and/or technical director of an echocardiography lab/program

It is suggested that you provide exact information as to how you meet the FASE criteria to the individuals writing your letters of recommendation.

FASE (Fellow of the American Society of Echocardiography) is an honorific credential recognizing dedicated ASE members who have demonstrated an extraordinary commitment to the field of cardiovascular ultrasound. This designation is awarded to physicians, sonographers, allied health professionals, scientists/researchers, and veterinarians who meet established criteria. The FASE credential does not confer certification, licensure, or authorization to independently practice specific modalities of cardiovascular ultrasound. Use of FASE honorific credential exclusively to obtain hospital credentials may result in loss of FASE designation.
